Vote by Mail Ballots to be canvassed will be available for public inspection for 30 minutes prior to each of the scheduled canvass meetings where vote by mail ballots are being processed. Immediately after convening the canvassing board, ballots will be opened and processed but tabulation results will not be released until after 7pm on March 19, Election Night.
