

The Supervisor of Elections Office will be publishing a 2022-2023 calendar with important election dates that will be handed out to members of the public at our office and at outreach events. The calendar will include pictures submitted to our office from students in Osceola County.

Here is how the contest will work:

-Teachers will facilitate the creation of election related pictures at their home schools. These can be any medium but must be landscape orientation and fit on an 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper. (A list of topic suggestions is included with this packet.)

- In order to be eligible, information relating to elections must be accurate and the art cannot support any particular political party or candidate.

-All artwork is to be submitted to the Supervisor of Elections Office by October 22 with the artist information. (The artist information form is included with this packet.)

-A Gallery Night will be held at the Supervisor of Elections Office on November 12. This event will be open to the public and all submitted artwork will be displayed. At this time, all attendees have the chance to vote for their favorite artwork in each age group (K-2, 3-5, 6-8 and 9-12).

The winners in each age group will be announced at the end of the night.

-The top 6 pieces of art from each of the four age groups will be featured in the 2022-2023 Elections Calendar.

-All participants will receive a small prize. The winners in each category will receive the small prize and a gift basket.
