## **Vote by Mail Requests Expired**

**Osceola County, FL** - Osceola County Supervisor of Elections, Mary Jane Arrington mails Vote by Mail Expired Mailer to voters whose request has expired.

We would like to remind registered voters that Vote by Mail requests expire after each Federal General Election Cycle. All Vote by Mail requests made before October 29, 2022, expired on December 31, 2022. For voters to continue to vote by mail, they must submit a new request each General Election Cycle.

"I would like to encourage voters to submit their new Vote by Mail request as soon as possible. And if they have any questions to feel free to call our office and we will gladly explain this new procedure mandated by the legislature" said Supervisor Arrington.

- Complete name, Residential address, Mailing address (if different from residential), Florida ID or Driver License number, or the last 4 digits of Social Security number, Date of Birth and Signature
