You can update this information with our office by submitting the voter registration form online at VoteOsceola.gov. You can also fill out a voter registration form at our office at 2509 E. Irlo Bronson Memorial Highway, Kissimmee FL 34744. For questions you can call the office at 407-742-6000.

Recent Events

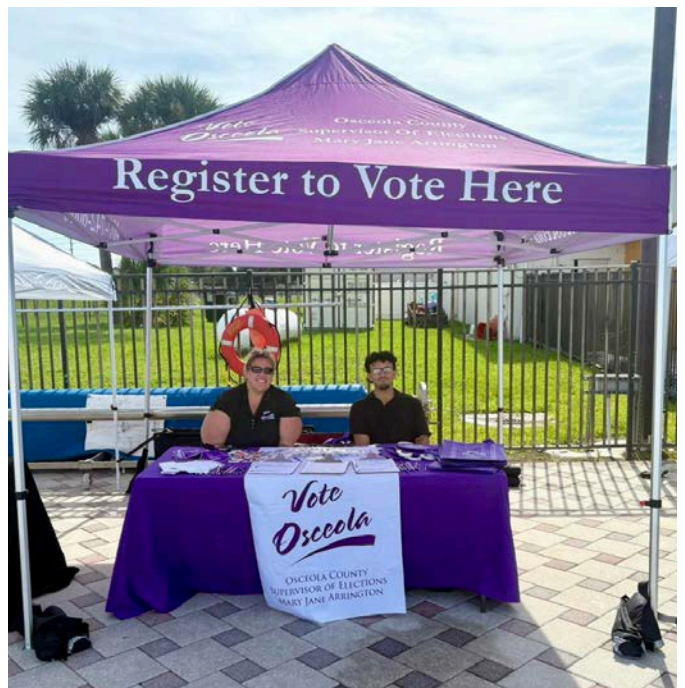
July

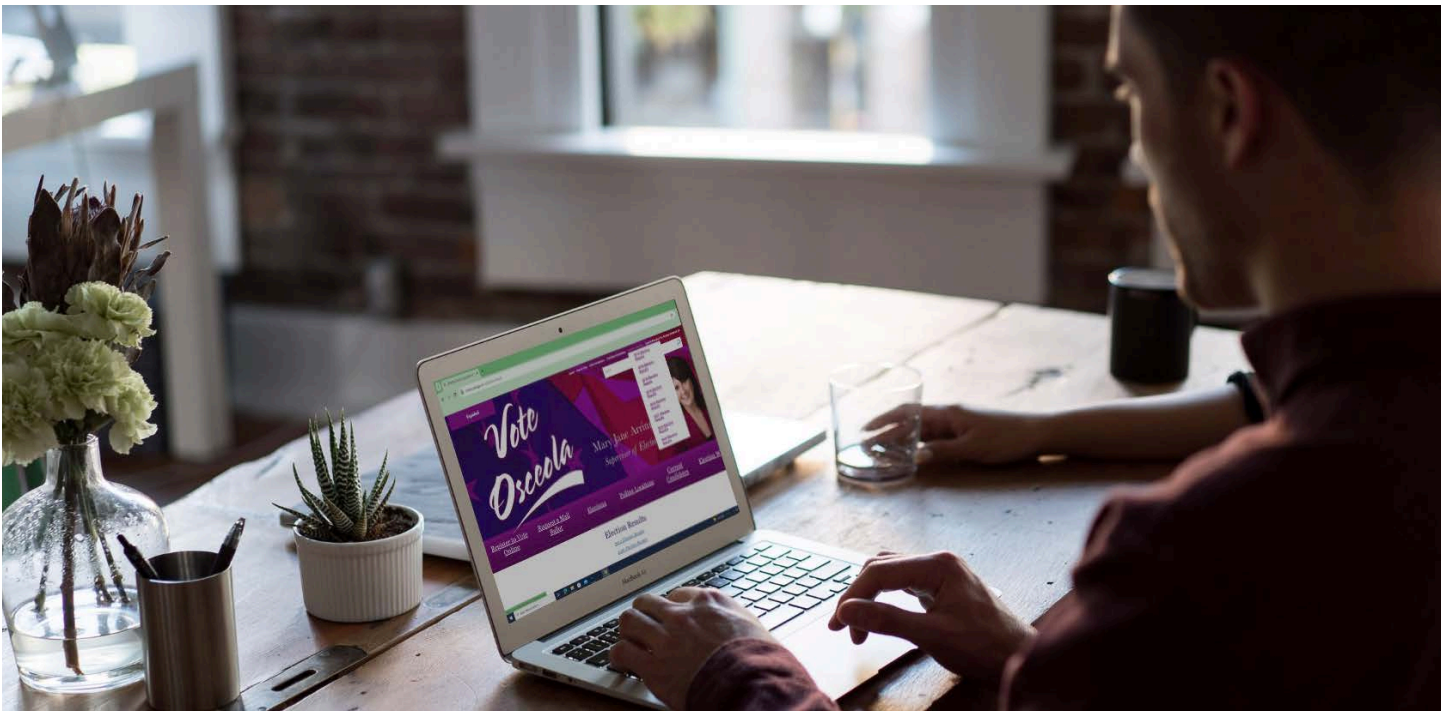
September

Public Records Requests

Did you know that most records in Florida are open to the public? Any member of the public can make a request for documents in our possession. The most commonly requested document is the voter registration roll but there are many others available. To place a public records request visit www.voteosceola.gov and click on the link “make a public records request” in the middle of the screen. This link leads to our public records request portal. From here, requestors can place individual requests or create an account to receive and house multiple requests.
